Carolyn will be traveling to Texas to be with our daughter Sarah during a procedure. Hopefully it will help to relieve some or all of the pain she has been experiencing over the past year. She had a blood clot in her left leg in April of 2012 and has been battling pain ever since. The first procedure, the stimulator trial, happens on March 4th. Then the temporary unit will be removed a few days later. If the stimulator trial is successful, Sarah will have a surgical procedure the next week to place a permanent neuro-stimulator. It will be kind of like a person who has pacemaker under the skin. But, instead of sending electrical impulses to the heart it will send them to nerves in her back. A small box will be surgically placed in her hip area. A wire will go to the spinal cord to stimulate the nerves that are sending pain messages to her left leg. She will trade the pain in her left leg for numbness. Then

she starts the process of weaning off of narcotics. We also found a counselor who specializes in chronic pain patients. Carolyn will be in Texas until July 22nd.
